2. Minutes (26.4.00) Agreed and Signed.
3. Matters Arising - 1) Memb. of Croquet Association. Letter of welcome from gen. sec. Nigel Graves and phone call, congratulations and welcome, from Chairman John Gaunt. 2) Press releases sent to Citizen / L.B. Observer and L.B. on Sunday. Also to 3 Counties radio re launch.
3) Insurance was arranged. Equipment not covered - I.D. to ask L. Hindson if it is covered under Council insurance. If not, M.B. will ask for quote from insurance co. Perkins-Slade Ltd.
4) Launch session - agreed successful. Special thanks to P. Davis and to L. Hindson / J. Bevington. I.D. to take card + flowers to L.H. / E.N. will give J.B. a bottle of wine.
4. Correspondence 1) Town council letter and conditions re bookings. Accidents involving medical treatment (and all accidents) should be reported by key holder + passed on by I.D. or M.B. for reporting on to Council. Accident book to be kept in cupboard and used.
2) Town council refused grant application and suggested we apply to Sports Council who dispense local grants on behalf of the Town Council.
3) An incorrect report appeared in the L.B.O. This was "corrected" by a letter submitted by sec.

- 6) Finance 1) Grant application to L.B. Sports Council submitted for consideration on Monday 15th May. Requested £200.
2) Financial situation outlined and discussed. Agreed Need more members. Agreed unable at present to increase number of sessions so will play members. Agreed unable at present to accommodate more than 8 players. Agreed Carmel time-limited (e.g. ½ hr. games) to accommodate more than 8 players. Agreed Carmel players/friends should be charged £2.50. Receipts copies and cash to be passed to treasurer by key-holder. Agreed People asked to contribute 10p (into book) if consume tea/coffee.
3) Treasurer to obtain duplicate order book
4) Payments due P. Davis £192 / M. Brown £48. No charge for ball boxes, n. letter or launch refreshments - thanks to T. Brown / E. Newman and M. Dilley.
- 7) Club Sessions 1) Register of attendance to be kept by sec. Signing-up copy to be kept in cupboard to be ticked by key holder. E.N. offered to produce copies of M.B.'s version on computer.
2) Keyholders Book - filled in until June 12th. Agreed at present will try to ensure comm. member present at each session to welcome people etc. + hold key.
3) Future bookings Agreed sec. to book further 4 wks. until July 1st. No change yet in days/times but to be reviewed once pattern of usage is clearer.
4) Club night - no formal night though Wed fpm. most popular. Possible club social event to be arranged in Autumn.
